All attendees to be made aware that travel to the ground should be in line with current government guidelines. All attendees to fill in Track & Trace form at entrance. Signage at entrance with covid-19 checklist for entry will also advise people to adhere to social distancing.	Everyone in attendance encouraged to wash hands, for at least 20 seconds, at regular intervals, using warm water & soap, preferably drying with disposable towels. Transmission of Covid-19 in Car Park	Staff, players, coaches, Managers, physios, officials, parents and general public	Provide unrestricted parking for staff, visitors etc. within the stadium footprint, which offers adequate space for all vehicles to be parked at safe distances apart. Transmission of Covid-19 at entrance	Staff, players, coaches, Managers, physios, officials, parents and general public	Entrance gate to remain open, with clearly marked one-way system in operation, to prevent build up at entrance and once inside the stadium. Hand sanitiser to be placed at entrance and exit of ground.	Send one-way system diagram to all parties in advance (and publish online) with a reminder to maintain social distancing where possible. Transmission of Covid-19 in dressing rooms and toilets	Staff, players, coaches, Managers, physios, officials, parents and general public	Changing rooms and toilets will be open but attendees will be encouraged not to utilise the facilities.	Email to participants encouraging them to arrive ready and not to use changing facilities. Signage on toilets to inform of number limitations. Cleaning products available for cleaning before & after use. Employ more frequent cleaning and stock checks.	AE	Ongoing	
Transmission of Covid-19 in during warm-ups	Staff, players, coaches, Managers, physios, officials, parents and general public	Separate areas for both teams and match officials to warm up. Utilising main pitch, area behind the pitch and Mears Meadows if required.	Communicate warm-up areas in advance with home side, opposition and match officials.	AE	Ongoing	
Transmission of Covid-19 in tunnel & during prematch handshake	Staff, players, coaches, Managers, physios, officials, parents and general public	Teams to enter field at separate times with prematch handshake to be scrapped.	Ensure both sides and officials are aware of this with match confirmation to be sent to all parties.	AE	Ongoing	
Transmission of Covid-19 during match	Staff, players, coaches, Managers, physios, officials, parents and general public	Shouting, Goal celebrations and spitting not permitted during match. Players should practice social distancing during matches when there are breaks in play. Any staff/supporters in attendance should follow social distancing guidelines and, preferably, wear facemasks. Signage to promote will be deployed around the ground. Regular PA announcements to remind about social distancing.	Ball should be handled only when absolutely necessary with disinfectant spray applied during stoppages. Additional seating to be made available for substitutes, coaches etc. First Aiders to be briefed of latest guidelines for attending to injuries to ensure correct PPE used.	AE	Ongoing	

Transmission of Covid-19 during match	Staff, players, coaches, Managers, physios, officials, parents and general public	Seating areas to be marked to limit availability and ensure social distancing is observed in those areas. Seats to be sanitised before, at half time and after match. Frequent cleaning of all spectator areas including rails before, during and after matches.		AE	Ongoing	
Transmission of Covid-19 in indoor areas, ie. Clubhouse	Staff, players, coaches, Managers, physios, officials, parents and general public	If clubhouse is open, then increased cleaning rota will be employed. Separate entrance and exit to be signed for one-way system. Social distancing to be employed in the clubhouse, with wearing of facemasks promoted. Perspex screen at bar to avoid transmission between staff and customers. Only one member of staff behind the bar. Cashless transactions to be promoted.	Disposable plastic cups to be used for drinks instead of glass. Signage to be placed throughout clubhouse along with lines to mark two metres. Drinks and food should only be consumed outdoors. Bins to be emptied more frequently. Tables spaced at 2 metres, with reduced seating capacity. Regular cleaning of door handles.	AE	Ongoing	
Transmission of Covid-19 post-match	Staff, players, coaches, Managers, physios, officials, parents and general public	Players will be asked to not shower post-match but to return home and launder their own kit and equipment used. All in attendance will be asked to take any litter with them for disposal after they have left the premises.		AE	Ongoing	
Attendee showing symptoms during match or training session	Staff, players, coaches, Managers, physios, officials, parents and general public	All staff, players, coaches etc. made aware that if anyone becomes unwell with a new continuous cough or a high temperature during the session or match, they should be sent home immediately and advised to follow the stay at home guidance. Signage at entrance to advise supporters to leave immediately by the closest exit & to follow the stay at home guidance if they become ill during the match.	Managers to keep record of players, coaches etc. in attendance for track & trace purposes.	AE	Ongoing
